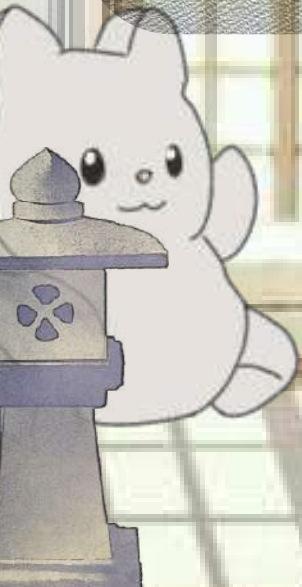


Once Upon A Time

The King and Queen were proud, but also very afraid. They decided to hide Aurora. The princess rarely saw the world and played only inside the grand palace.

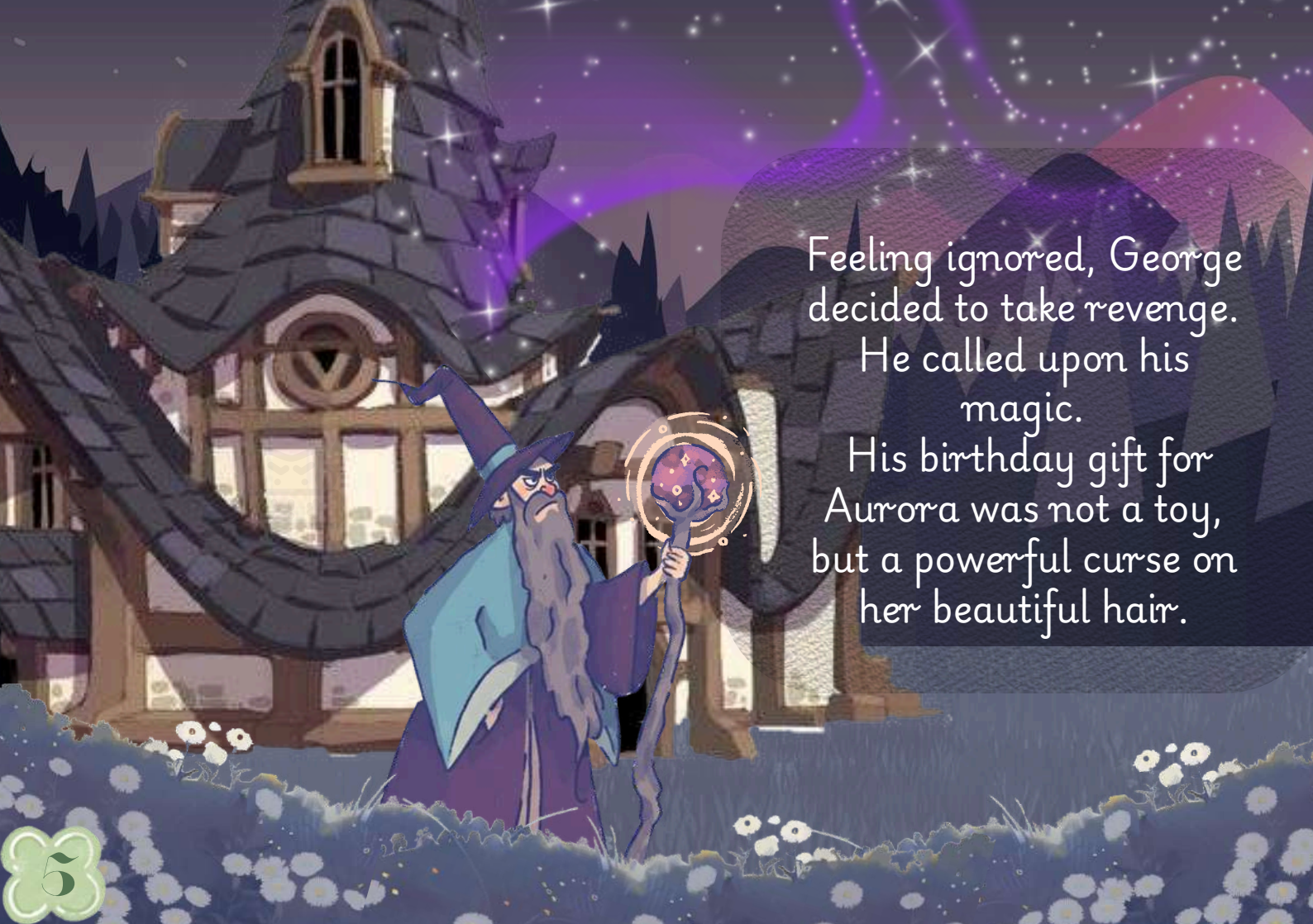

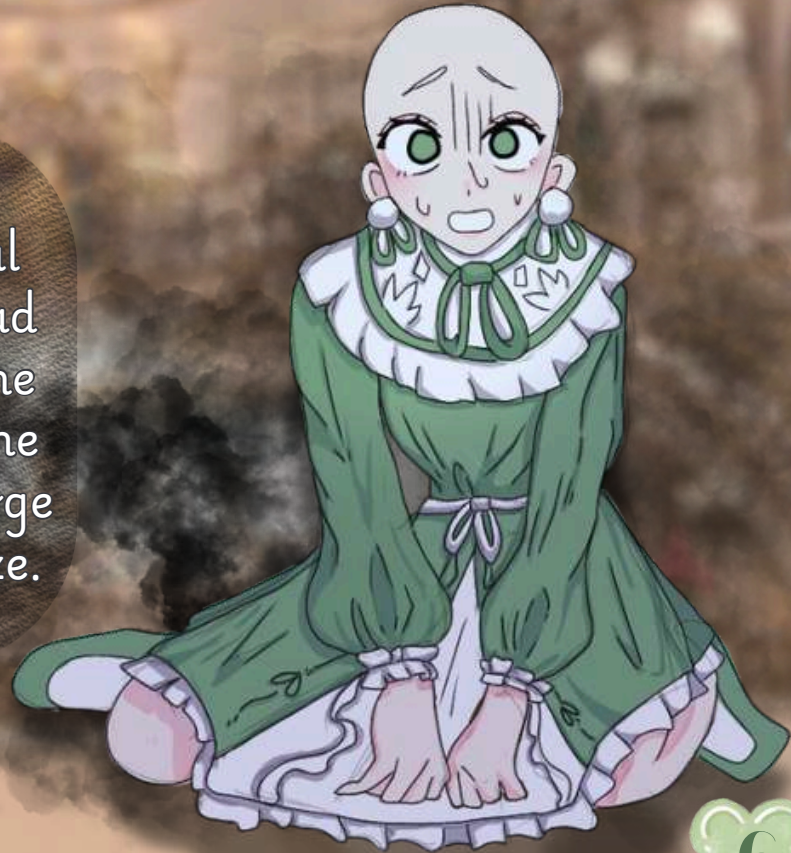


That person was George, a strange old man who lived alone by the sea. When he saw the bright party lights from his lonely shore, he became very angry.







George refused and said, "Her hair will not return until the princess learns that true beauty lies in the heart, not just in appearance." Then, he disappeared.





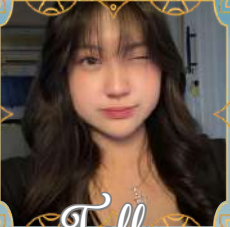
